

CITY OF RIVER BLUFF, KENTUCKY  
ORDINANCE NO. 1, SERIES 1987-88

ORDINANCE ADOPTING A SPEED LIMIT AND PENALTIES FOR EXCEEDING THE SPEED  
LIMIT ON THE STREETS OF THE CITY OF RIVER BLUFF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF RIVER BLUFF:

SECTION 1. No operator of a vehicle on city streets shall drive at a greater speed than is reasonable and prudent, having regard for the traffic and for the condition and use of the street.

SECTION 2. Whereas the City Commission of the City of River Bluff has determined that the speed permitted by KRS 189.390 on highways in business and residential districts is greater than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist in the City of River Bluff, the maximum speed on city streets is declared to be 25 m.p.h.

SECTION 3. Authorized emergency vehicles shall comply with the provisions of this Ordinance subject to these exceptions:

1. The operator of any such vehicle performing emergency duties so long as he does not endanger life or property may exceed the lawful speed limit; and,

2. The operator of any vehicles of the Fire Department in answering an alarm of fire and operators of any vehicles of the Police Department in answering emergency calls or in actual pursuit of law violators may exceed the lawful speed limit and proceed past a red or stop signal or stop sign, but only after slowing down as may be necessary for safe operation.

SECTION 4. Whoever violates Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be fined according to KRS 189.394.

SECTION 5. Section 3 notwithstanding the driver of any emergency or public safety vehicle shall drive with due regard for the safety of all persons and property upon city streets.

SECTION 6. Whoever violates Section 3 of this Ordinance shall be penalized according to KRS 189.993(9).

SECTION 7. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to publish this Ordinance as required by law.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
