

CITY OF RIVER BLUFF
MAYOR-COMMISSION BOARD
MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 25, 2020

The Mayor-Commission Board for the City of River Bluff met on February 25, 2020 at the New Goshen Presbyterian Church at 7:30 p.m. Members present were Mayor Bryan Dillon, Lynn Grossman, Laura Hansen and Chris Crace. The following residents were present: Jeff Amann James Coke. Officer Murray was present from the Oldham County Police and City Clerk, Katie Buhts was in attendance.

Oldham County Police Report

During the month of January, there were twenty-one contracted details. There were three courtesy notices issued during the contracted detail. Two were for stop sign violations and one was for speeding. There was one citation issued during the contracted detail. It was for speeding. Officers made nine citizen contacts in the City of River Bluff.

Chris Crace asked Officer Murray if there were any changes in criminal patterns recently. He replied that in his experience, this has not been an issue.

The commission unanimously approved 40 hours of police patrols through May 2020.

Questions/Concerns from Residents –Discussion of roadway parking took place. Katie Buhts will post on the city's Facebook page to urge residents to use garages and driveways to reduce the opportunity for criminal activities.

Minutes -- The January 2020 minutes were approved as sent.

Treasurer's Report -- The January 2019 financial reports were approved.

Old Business

Community Pride – Lynn Grossman updated the commissioners missing shrubs that were removed by LG&E on July 25, 2019. Michael Gray of LG&E walked the island in February and cannot identify why the shrubs were removed. LG&E issued a check for \$901 to replace the shrubs. The city will deposit these funds.

Drainage Issues

To date, no new updates on the ongoing drainage work.

Emergency Plan Update

Commissioner Chris Crace informed the commissioners about a program that would allow River bluff to apply for surplus government supplies. All agreed that since this is at no-cost, Mr. Crace should complete the application.

Katie Buhts will create a city clerk training manual. A draft will be ready for review in two months. Additionally, Mrs. Buhts will research credit and debit cards available to River Bluff at PNC.

River Bluff Road

Mr. Crace proposed researching what could legally be done with the unpaved ending of River Bluff Road. Mayor Dillon will reach out to John Treitz to determine if anything can legally be done with the roadway. Mr. Crace would like to consider alternate uses for the roadway since it is unused land.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
