Governing Body

To provide some background information on our city, in August of 1980 the Mayor Commissioner form of government, made up of a Mayor and four members of a commission, was adopted by the City of River Bluff. As such, our city issues tax bills on an annual basis. These are mailed to our residents the first week of August, and due September 30. We do not have a Homeowners Association, as this business is handled by our governing body.

Your commission meets the fourth Tuesday of the month at New Goshen Presbyterian Church at 7:30pm. Any changes to this schedule will be communicated via Facebook, our website and the Oldham Era.

CITY SERVICES

WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES

Trash service is provided weekly Wednesday mornings, and recycling is a bi-weekly service. The City has a franchise agreement with Waste Management for each residence to have one rolling cart for trash, one for recycling, and one bulk item per weekly pickup. Annually, the City offers Bulk Pickup twice per year, on the third Wednesdays of April and October.

INSURANCE SURCHARGES

In compliance with Kentucky State Law you are charged an 11% sales tax on your insurance needs. This tax is added to your insurance bill and collected by your insurance company. This tax money is supposed to be distributed by your insurance company as follows: 1% to the State of Kentucky and 10% to the City of River Bluff. However, a significant amount of the money collected, which is properly due to the city, is not currently tendered to us. This is due to a lack of accountability and an incorrect "code" applied to your policy. The correct code for the City of River Bluff is "0457".

Please contact your insurance company or agent and verify that your tax money is properly being sent to the City of River Bluff as directed. This call will not increase the amount of your bill; rather it will get the money already collected delivered to the City of River Bluff.

OLDHAM COUNTY POLICE

The City of River Bluff's Commission is dedicated to the safety of the city's residents. Each month, the City contracts with the Oldham County Police Department for additional patrols in our neighborhood. The dispatch, non-emergency contact number for the Oldham County Police is 502-222-0111.
