OCPD Report

Officer Toler updated the board that juveniles from the Metro area have been in the area rummaging through unlocked vehicles at night. They are going as far north as Carroll County. As always, OCPD recommends that residents do not leave valuables in their vehicles overnight, they lock car doors and close garage door in the evening. The prime window of opportunity for these criminals is 12-5AM. Discussion regarding this ongoing issue took place.

Questions/Comments from Residents – James Coke raised the concern about the ongoing noise at the sewage facility. Katie Buhts will attempt to work with Bluegrass Water over the upcoming weeks to improve this issue.
